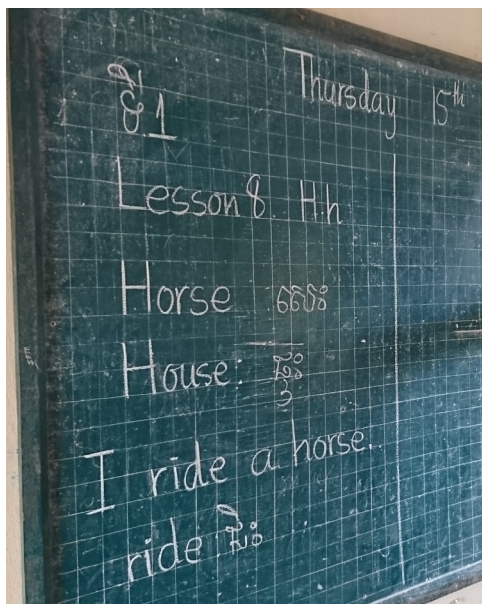
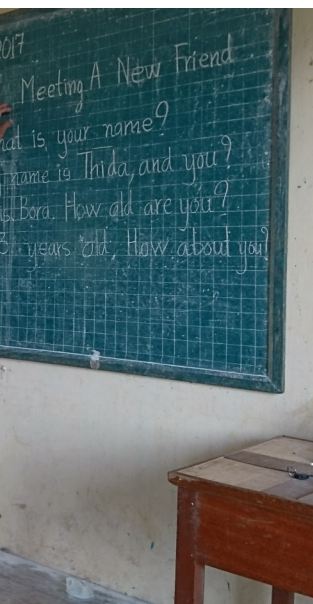
Work of the fence was completed on 1st June, and a donation of USD 1125 was made to the school on 15th June.

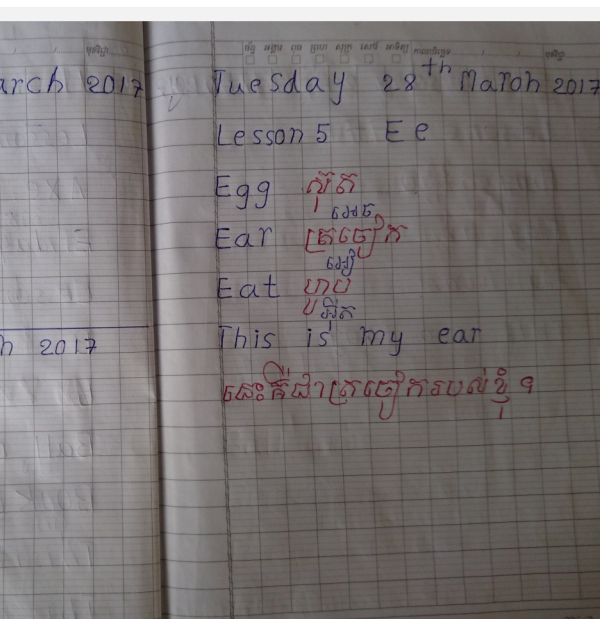

language is not a compulsory subject to be taught in India. In order to improve the level of education the foundation has decided to employ an English teacher at the school. A budget of USD 900 was approved by the board of directors in December 2016, the plan was to employ her for a probation of six months with a monthly



difficult in a province to find a full time English teacher, the foundation employed instead of a full time teacher in March 2017, a part time teacher into the school five days a week from 3:30pm to 5:30pm. The foundation also arranged a special time table for the English class so that all students would have the opportunity to attend the class. The monthly salary of the part time teacher was agreed to be USD 900. After two months as a probation period, it was then decided to

Ms. Theresa Kwok from Better Schools Foundation goes to the school on a monthly basis to check the progress of the English level of the students. She is very satisfied with it. In order to sustain the level of education at the school, Better Schools Foundation does have a long term plan to employ an English Teacher, and this will be reviewed on the basis of the progress of the English teacher (up to June 2018).



Primary School in Kompong Chhnang Prov



Vailsborv Primary School was built in 2010 and Better Schools Foundation is sponsoring them in 2015; at the time of building the structure of this school was very poor, there was no electricity, no water and no toilet. Then Better Schools Foundation provided the electricity and water for the school by installing a solar panel, and installing a water tank. Furthermore, we built a toilet and water basin.



Primary School currently only has 2 classrooms which are very poor. The school has to borrow a room from the neighbour; the school's condition is also very poor,

This year, Better Schools Foundation has decided to build 2 new classrooms for the school; and after consultation with two local builders, a contract of USD 15,232.00 was agreed. The contract was signed between the headmaster of the school and the project was also approved by the Ministry of Education on the 25th July, then by the Ministry of Education on the 26th July).

Work is expected to start in early August, once Better Schools Foundation has made the initial donation. The work is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

When the classrooms are built, Better Schools Foundation will provide the necessary furniture (desks, chairs, blackboards). It is not yet clear if the existing classrooms are still usable or not. The budget of this is to be determined.
